PAINT PARTY - NOVEMBER 3 & 4

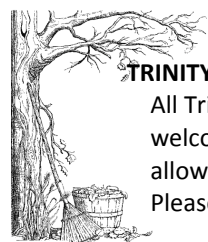

VETERAN'S DAY - NOVEMBER 11

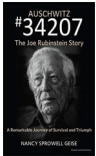
