## **OUTSOURCING FINANCIAL FUNCTIONS**

The Session has approved the outsourcing of Trinity's financial functions to a local CPA firm (Mikoleit, Inc.). Effective January 1, 2019, the disbursements/payments function will be outsourced, while effective January 1, 2020, the donations/contributions function will be outsourced. This phased approach will help us ease into the transition and mitigate the impact of this change upon the Finance Committee and church staff.

Trinity has been blessed with talented and dedicated volunteers who have served as Treasurer and Financial Secretary, and the congregation owes them a HUGE debt of gratitude for the significant time commitments they have made. Outsourcing will eliminate the potential of "burning out" volunteers, while also providing much-needed back-up in that more than one person at the CPA firm will have the capability to perform these functions.

The Presbyterian Youth Triennium is a five day event for high school age youth (entering freshmen through graduated seniors). The Youth Triennium occurs every three years.
