Blue Out Sunday (Wear something Blue) March 10

The first Sunday in Lent is designated "Wear your blue t-shirt to church Sunday" as a testament of one of the ways One Great Hour of Sharing makes a difference. Blue Out Sunday recognizes the vital work of Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA). Thousands of volunteers each year put on a blue t-shirt that says "Out of chaos, Hope." They bear not only ladders and drywall for rebuilding, but also the love of God. They've worked shoulder-to-shoulder to live out Christ's call to serve their neighbors in need. Many disaster survivors who see the love of God evident in the lives of these servants are able to take off their cloak of mourning and begin to find joy.

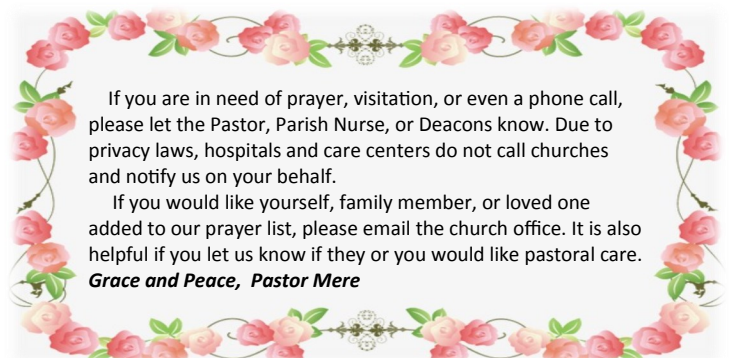
