




June 5- August 28, 9:30 to 10:15 a.m. (see exceptions below)

Professor Bart Ehrman has won several awards for excellence in teaching and is the chair of the Department of Religious Studies at





HARVESTERS food is distributed the 2nd Monday of every month at Trinity Presbyterian Church in the paved parking lot.



GRAB & GO FREE SUMMER MEALS

Trinity has been approved to be a site for USD 501 FREE Grab & Go Meals distribution for children 1-18 years of age while school is out for the summer. The 7 breakfasts and 7 lunches, milk and juice is provided free through the Summer Food Service Program of USD 501.

Any child age 1-18 is eligible to receive these meals. **No registration or enrollment in USD 501 is required.** If you know of families with children, pass the word!

Pickup is at Trinity Presbyterian Church, 4746 SW 21st St. (21st & Sims) in the north parking lot between 11 am and noon every Friday in June and July (June 3, 10, 17, 24, July 1, 8, 15, 22 29).

Parents, grandparents or friends can pick the meals up. (Kids do not need to be present at pick up).


