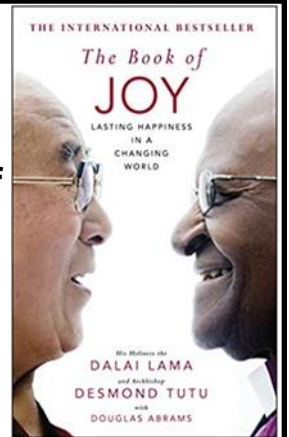
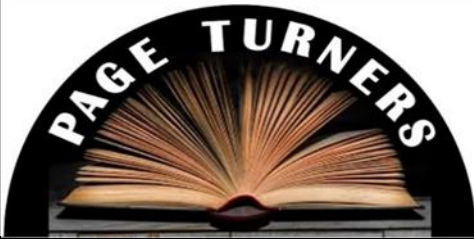

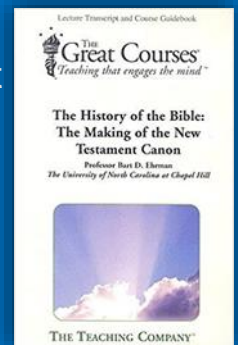
**June 5- August 28, 9:30 to 10:15 a.m. (see exceptions below)**

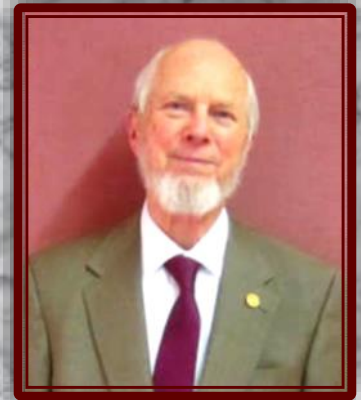

## GRAB & GO FREE SUMMER MEALS

Trinity has been approved to be a site for USD 501 **FREE Grab & Go Meals** distribution for **children 1-18 years of age** while school is out for the summer. **The 7 breakfasts and 7 lunches, milk and juice is provided free** through the Summer Food Service Program of USD 501.

Any child age 1-18 is eligible to receive these meals. **No registration or enrollment in USD 501 is required.** If you know of families with children, pass the word!

Pickup is at **Trinity Presbyterian Church, 4746 SW 21st St.** (21st & Sims) in the north parking lot between **11 am and noon every Friday** in **June and July** (June 3, 10, 17, 24, July 1, 8, 15, 22 29).

Parents, grandparents or friends can pick the meals up. (Kids do not need to be present at pick up).
