Come and enjoy some brats cooked over a campfire, great fellowship, and spectacular views of rural Kansas.

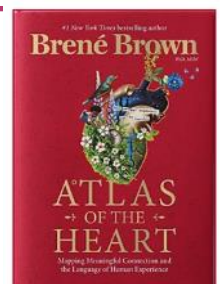
Carpools will be leaving **Trinity at 4:00 pm** for any who wish to share a ride. A **\$5.00** contribution will cover your meal and beverages.

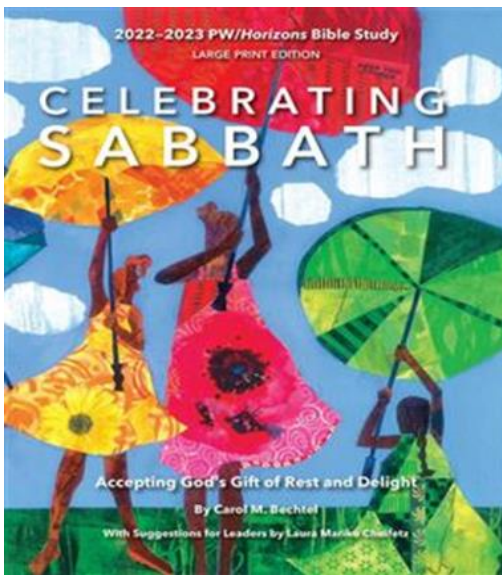

The Theme for this nine-month study is "Celebrating Sabbath".

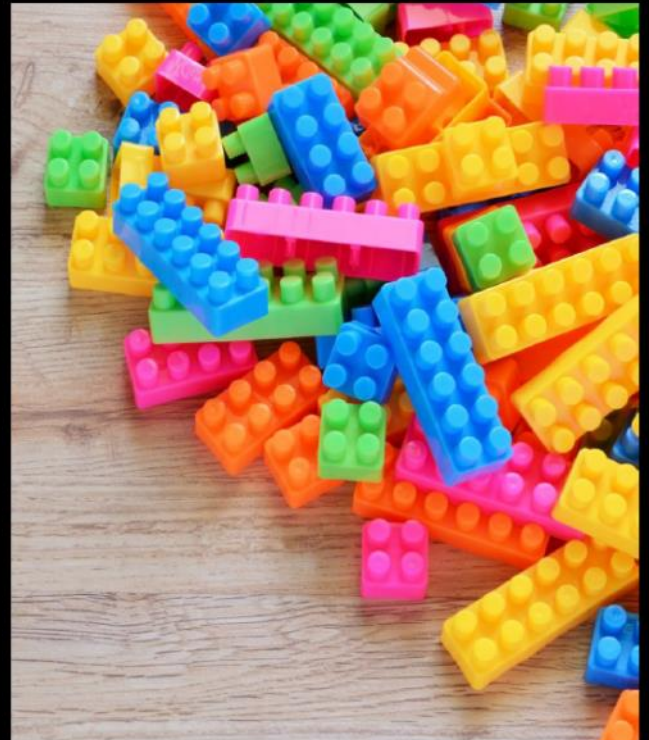
The study begins Wednesday, September 7. Both of Trinity's Circles will use this study. **All are welcome to attend.**
