


# REMINDERS/NOTICES

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday--a time to reflect on our mortality and prepare for the spiritual journal through Lent. We wear ashes on our forehead to remind us that even though we are dust, and return to dust, God's love remains with us.

This year, our Ash Wednesday Service will have a different format. We are gathering in the Fellowship Hall for worship and an opportunity to participate in worship through prayer stations. A Prayer Station is a small, interactive activity that engages the senses and invites deeper reflection. For example, at one prayer station, worshippers will have an opportunity to dip their fingers in the baptismal font and remember our own baptisms.






**HARVESTERS** food distribution occurs on the 2nd MONDAY of every month at Trinity. It is on a first come,


