

March is just around the corner which is Trinity's month to stock the pantry shelves at Doorstep. The **BUY THE CASE** program is underway to place the orders for cases of food. The order form can be filled out and mailed to the church or dropped in the offering box with your check or money. We will have

The BUY THE CASE program is a Mission Committee program that makes it SIMPLE for Trinity folks to buy cases of food at a tax free and discounted price to donate to DOORSTEP.

the forms, and blank envelopes at the church. The form has areas that you can select the quantity of cases you desire and the total price of those cases There is also an area to show any undesignated gift which will be used to cover changes in food prices, and the balance will be given to Doorstep to purchase any additional food they may need..

These rates are discounted and tax free that we purchase from Apple Market. The form explains all the information that is needed. Doorstep distributes the food to those that need nourishment, and that number increases as time goes by.

This year we will again be taking the cases directly to Doorstep each week so it can be distributed as needed. We will keep you up to date on how many cases we are providing with a thermometer at the church showing the current count.





Trinity is well known for our mission work and the Mission Committee joyfully answers the call to serve God by serving others. We believe in the Trinity mission statement of "Glorify God, Share Christ's love, and Make New Disciples".



Our goal is to reach out to our community and beyond to support and fulfill their needs. We are always looking for new ways to be of service. There are many opportunities to serve others and make a difference in people's lives.

We coordinate a variety of projects for Doorstep throughout the year by seeking donations of food, supplies, clothing, and blankets as well as helping to raise money for them. We hold a Harvester's food distribution in our parking lot the second Monday of every month. During non-pandemic times, we make and serve food at Let's Help and Topeka Rescue Mission, and many of our members volunteer in other capacities.

Some of our other projects include 501 school lunches, Stormont Vail mobile clinic in our parking lot, Christmas Angel Tree to gather supplies to benefit the group of our choice. We coordinate special offerings for One Great Hour of Sharing and Christmas Joy which assists church leaders among us. We support our Presbytery monetarily so they can coordinate more global needs.
