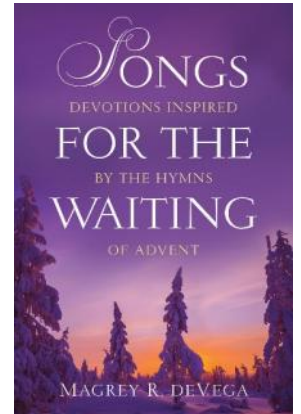
THANK YOU FOR COMING!



I was on hold with the cable company the other week—probably one of my least favorite adult chores in the world. Every so often, a robotic voice assured me that “my call was important” and that “a customer service representative would be with me shortly.” In between announcements, tinny music played on the phone line. As the wait prolonged, and the music played on loop, I recalled how often music is used to help us endure the wait-times. On this phone call, the jazzy notes were an (unsuccessful) attempt to make a boring chore more exciting. While waiting in line at an amusement park, music can help heighten expectation and excitement for the upcoming ride. Or, as we enter the holiday season, merchants will pipe in Christmas music over the loudspeakers, with hope that hearing “Jingle Bell Rock” will make the customer service line flow faster.

During worship this Advent, we are going to listen to sing and reflect on some “songs for the waiting.” Waiting for the birth of Jesus can sometimes feel as interminable as being on hold with customer service. We want to skip to the “good parts!” The music of Advent plays an essential role in telling the story of God’s love that stretches across centuries to our present day. Some of the songs we will sing may be well known by you; others may be new tunes or unfamiliar words. My hope and prayer is that these songs will be added to your own personal Advent musical playlist, their melodies carrying us along the road, until we arrive singing at the manger.

Side note: Our worship series is adapted from an excellent Advent devotional book, *Songs for the Waiting*, by Magrey R. DeVega. If you would like to dive deeper into more songs for waiting, you can purchase this book from your favorite bookseller, such as Amazon or pcusastore.com.

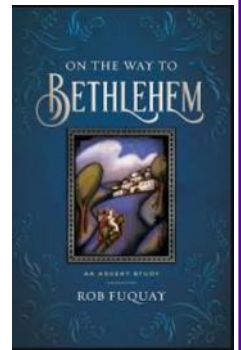

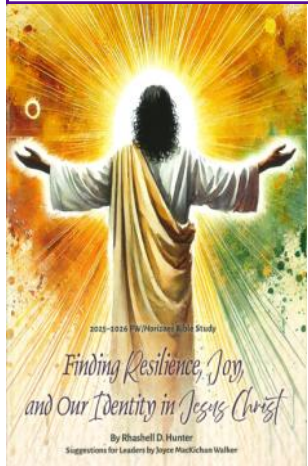
On the Way to Bethlehem: an Advent Study

Please remember to use the "Memo" line on your checks so your financial gifts will be directed to the correct Donations Account – for example, "Pledge." Checks are separated from envelopes, and a blank Memo line can create confusion in the counting process. Please assist our accounting partners!



Online-Bank Bill Payment:

A service offered by most financial institutions, which creates automatic recurring or one-time gift payments electronically from your bank account. Designate Trinity as the payee, and have payments sent to: **Trinity Presbyterian Church, 4746 SW 21st Street, Topeka, KS 66604**



Online-Trinity Giving:

You can find this option on Trinity's website at www.trinitypresbyterian.net

Select the "Give" tab in the upper right portion of the screen and follow the instructions. Special Offerings may also be designated.

NOTE: This form of giving is especially *secure*. It will not be lost in the mail and cannot be stolen from the outdoor mailbox!

Another way to give via the website:

1. Scan the purple image [QR code] on this page with your smartphone.
2. Open the link that pops up, and you will be taken directly to the Online Giving page for Trinity.
3. Select the fund (s), and you can easily make your financial gift.



Cash:

Cash offerings should only be given in a worship service – do not mail! Please consider using a Pew envelope and label it with your name, if desired. If you do not indicate a fund, it will be recorded as a gift for the General Operating Budget.



Required Minimum Distributions:

Are you considering donating all or part of your RMD (Required Minimum Distribution) as a Qualified Charitable Distribution to Trinity? If so, please notify Susan Bozeman (785-224-0433 or skboze@gmail.com) of your intention, as well as instruct your financial institution or advisor to indicate the ownership of this type of gift on the accompanying documentation. This identity information, such as your name and directions for your gift, greatly assists our accounting partners with the correct and timely recording of your gift.



Gentle Reminder: Thank you to all who continue to contribute to the **Per Capita** fund. Trinity makes this payment to Presbytery on behalf of the membership of Trinity. We ask for a contribution of **\$40 per member**. Any difference in the funds collected and when the payment is due is made up from the General Operating Budget.

Your Stock Gifts

If you are considering a gift of mutual funds or appreciated securities, Trinity suggests you begin to initiate your transfers by Friday, December 5, 2025 to allow sufficient time to process your gift. Please contact Dennis Williams, Financial Manager, before you make the transaction. Our broker will notify Trinity of the amount of the sale, and the name of the stock - but we have no way of knowing the donor or purpose of the fund or stock gift. Knowing ahead of time about your gift helps track the transaction and correctly record it.

The 2025 giving statements will be mailed in January so you will have them before you begin tax preparation.

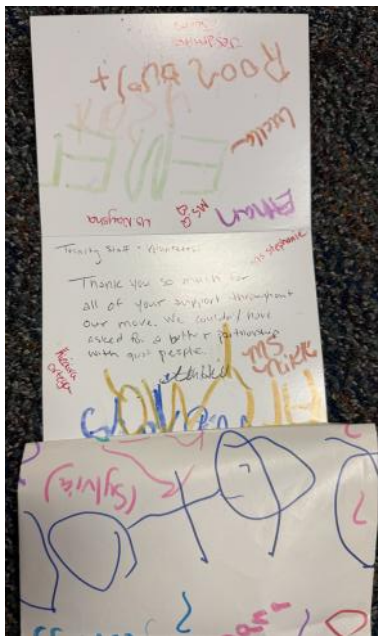
Your Pre-Paid 2026 Pledges

In response to additional needs by SNAP recipients, Doorstep and other agencies are working together through OH, SNAP! Money donated through the community drive including by fire fighters at intersections will be funneled through United Way to 5 helping agencies in Topeka including Doorstep. Each agency will use the funds both for their own needs and to assist local food pantries across the city so that the organizations already prepared to meet the needs can meet additional needs.
