July 12 through August 30

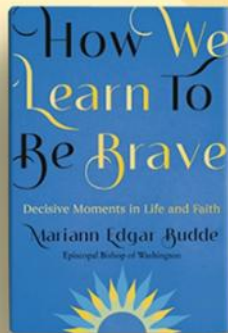
The Story of God with Morgan Freeman

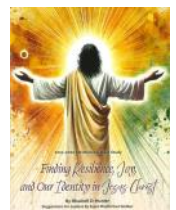

Trinity Photo Directory FAQ's

☺ **Am I required to include my picture in the Photo Directory?**

★ No, but we would like to include everyone and will miss you if you decide not to be included.

☺ **Can I submit a digital photo I already have and like?**

★ Yes. Digital photos must clearly show your head and shoulders, be a landscape orientation and allow adequate background for sizing. **If you submit a digital photo, please email to Photos@trinitypresbyterian.net by May 3rd.**

☺ **LAST CHANCE: Photos will be taken beginning immediately after worship on May 3. Do I need to sign up for a specific time?**

★ No. Once you check in with Susan Bozeman, you will quickly move through the line to the photographer. There will be places to sit and refreshments available while you wait.

☺ **Am I required to dress in any certain way?**

★ No. The way you normally dress for worship is great.

☺ **How will the Photo Directory be distributed?**

★ The Photo Directory will be emailed to the congregation. Additionally, a limited number of printed copies will be available.

☺ **Will the professional photographer attempt to sell me photos?**

April starts a new school year in the Talpetates school. Unlike U.S. schools whose school year go from August through May, the Salvadoran school year starts in March and continues through November.

Recently the school put pictures from the beginning of the year on its Facebook page: meetings, time to play in the schoolyard, re-engaging with friends, and having lunch. There are about 300 students in the school this year in grades pre-kindergarten through ninth grade. Thank you for the generous support of Trinity members who provide salaries for two school personnel and a nutrition program at the school. In addition, many generous donors have contributed for high school scholarships and college scholarships. Over 130 students have gone to high school and about 25 have completed college.

Did you know?

The land that Trinity Presbyterian Church now occupies was once the home to the nations of the Kaw, Otoe-Missouri, Kickapoo, and Osage. Westward expansion and government policies forcibly removed Indigenous peoples from their homelands to reservations in Kansas and Oklahoma.

In 1846 the Potawatomi reservation was established covering 568,223 acres including parts of present-day Topeka.

In 1854 Kansas was opened to "white" settlement, and land ownership was sometimes deemed "squatter sovereignty."

Treaties in 1861 and again in 1867 greatly reduced the reservation. For example, about 300,000 of those acres were given to the railroads and some land was given to religious groups.

The Dawes Act of 1887 promoted the concept of individual farms on allotted lands for Indians or native peoples, whereas the traditions of the tribes had always been that the land was held in common. The Dawes Act attempted to make Indian land ownership and economic and cultural life like that of the white settlers.

In 1954 the Potawatomi sent delegates to Congress to petition against the Termination List. This legislation would have "done away" with tribal recognition. The Potawatomi wanted to remain a federally-recognized tribe. Particularly the Prairie Band of the Potawatomi Nation has argued for their independence and against usurpations of their lands. They have a prosperous reservation near Mayetta. No other Indigenous nation has had so many treaties with the federal government, with 44 cessations.

On **Earth Day**, let us recognize the gifts of creation and reaffirm our commitment to good stewardship of the environment, and also honor our Indigenous siblings who have been companions of the lands, waters, and beings of Topeka and Shawnee County since time immemorial.

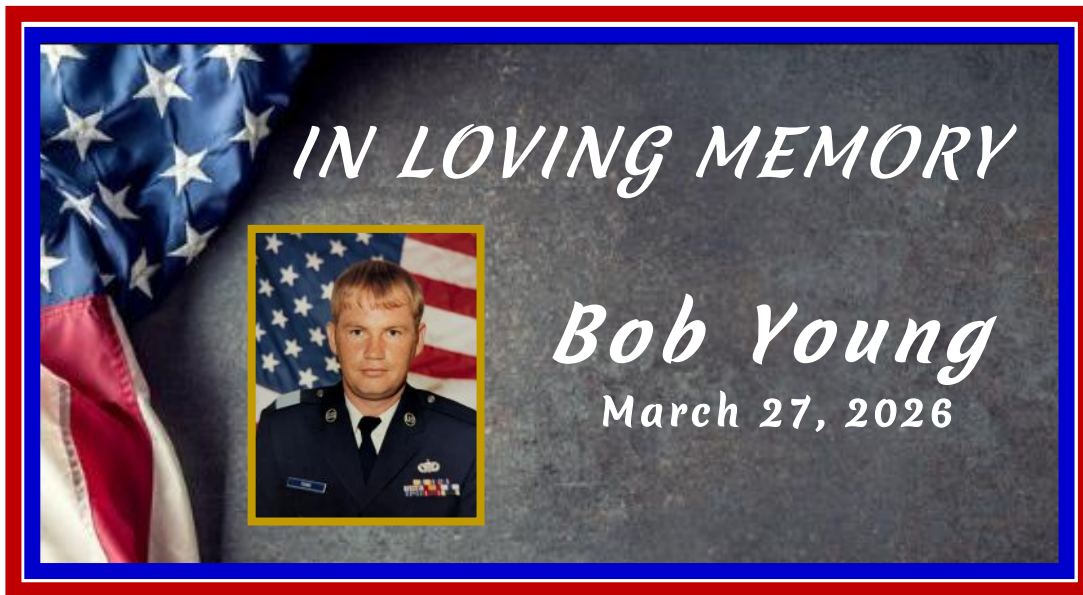
