Please note "Birthday Gift" in the memo line of your check.





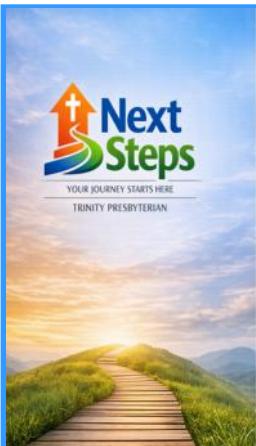
## Join us on Wednesday, May 27th, 10:30am Trinity Presbyterian Church in Fellowship Hall.

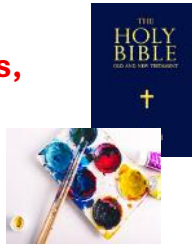

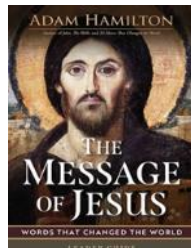
Sundays, July 12 thru August 30

- The series features actor Morgan Freeman who explores various cultures and religions and their take on religion-related topics, particularly their belief in a God or a higher power.

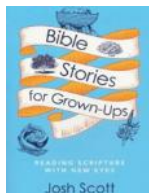
Sundays, September 13 thru October 18

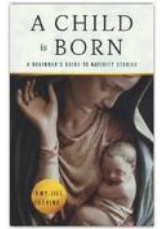
Sundays, October 25 thru November 22
