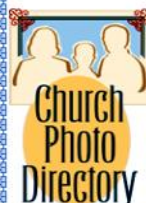

**National Geographic presents: *The Story of God with Morgan Freeman***

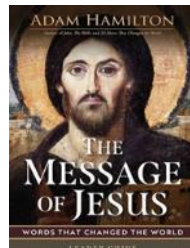
- The series features actor Morgan Freeman who explores various cultures and religions and their take on religion-related topics, particularly their belief in a God or a higher power.

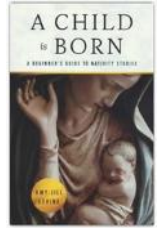
***Bible Stories for Grown-Ups: Reading Scripture with New Eyes*, by Josh Scott**

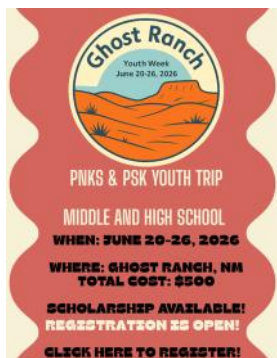

- Meals during the event

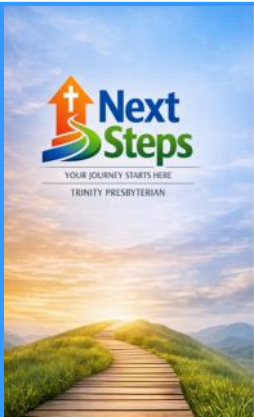
**What's not covered:** lunch while traveling to the Ghost Ranch; dinner traveling home from GR; any "extras" that may be purchased along the way

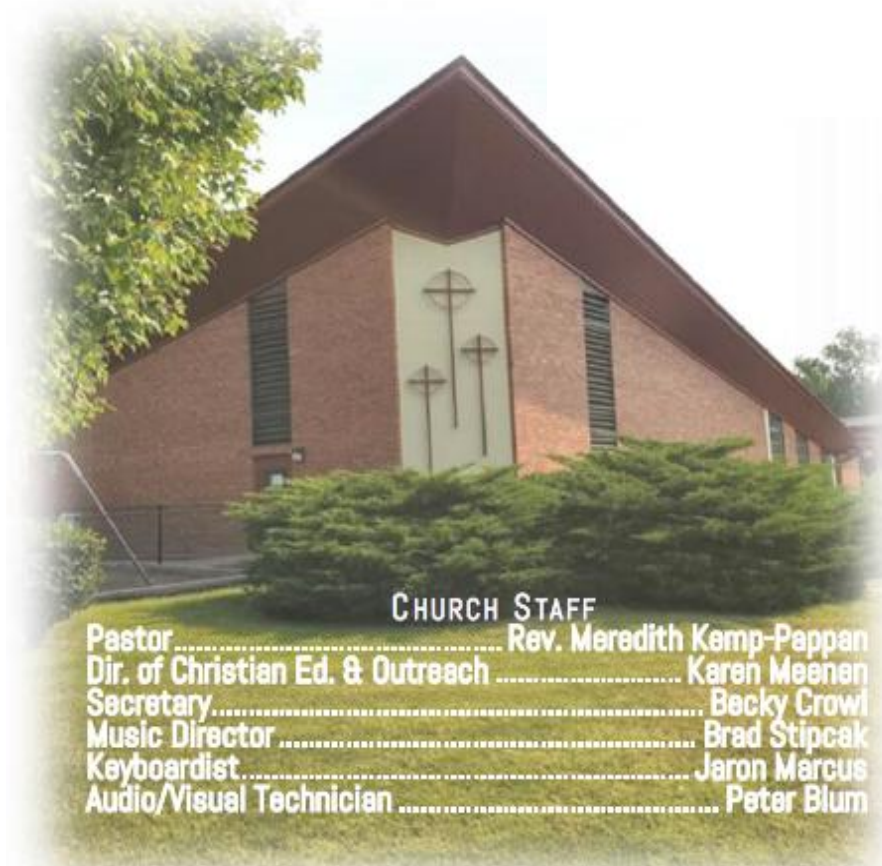
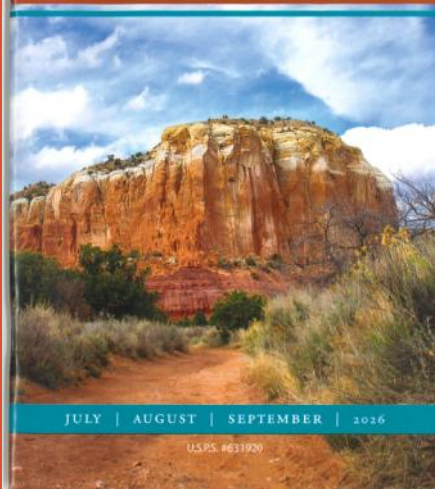
